

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Tohono O'odham Judicial Services -  
Juvenile Diversion Intervention Program)

RES. NO. 151-88

1 WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Public Safety (ADPS) solicited  
2 proposals for funding of criminal justice related  
3 services under the Justice Assistance Act of 1984; and

4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Judiciary submitted an application  
5 seeking funds to fund a juvenile diversion/intervention  
6 program; and

7 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Judiciary's application has been  
8 funded in the amount requested and necessitates  
9 acceptance by the Legislative Council before the project  
10 can begin; and

11 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is supportive of the Judiciary's  
12 efforts to address the problems and needs of the Tohono  
13 O'Odham youth coming into contact with the criminal  
14 justice system; and

15 WHEREAS, the Juvenile Diversion/Intervention Program is a viable  
16 alternative approach to the traditional method of  
17 incarceration often inappropriate for juveniles  
18 committing delinquent acts while under the influence of  
19 alcohol, drugs or toxic vapors; and

20 WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Public Safety funds will  
21 greatly enhance the ability of the Juvenile  
22 Diversion/Intervention Program to obtain equipment and  
23 services deemed essential to successful implementation  
24 of the program goals and objectives.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that it  
26 does hereby support and accept the funds granted by the  
27 Arizona Department of Public Safety to fund the Tohono  
28 O'Odham Judiciary's Juvenile Diversion/Intervention  
29 Program.

30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
31 that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Treasurer of the
