

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Title VI Elderly Budget Amendment)

RES. NO. 152-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the
2 Title VI Elderly Program under a grant with the Office
3 of Human Development Services, Administration of Aging;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels
6 of the contract shall be submitted for review and
7 approval by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council; and

8 WHEREAS, an amendment has been submitted for review and approval
9 by the Title VI Elderly Program.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham
11 Legislative Council does hereby approve the amendment to
12 the Title VI Elderly Program.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and the
14 Treasurer of the Tohono O'Odham Nation are hereby
15 authorized to negotiate and execute the grant and
16 amendments thereto for the duration of the grant,
17 provided however, that any amendments affecting the
18 funding and funding levels of the grant shall be
19 submitted for further prior approval by this Council.


20 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
21 on the 20th. day of June, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum
22 was present with a vote of 1,255.5 for; 85.0 against; 58.5
23 the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution
24 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham
25 Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy
26 Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
27 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
28 Stat. 984).
