

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Tohono O'Odham Community Health Services)

RES. NO. 154-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the  
2 Community Health Services Program under FY '88 P. L. 93-  
3 638 contract with the Public Health Indian Health  
4 Services; and

5 WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and  
6 beneficial to the Tohono O'Odham Nation and its people;  
7 and

8 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Section 271.20 of the Federal Regulations  
9 requires that all proposals to recontract under P. L.  
10 93-638 be submitted to the Tohono O'Odham Council for  
11 approval at least 120 days prior to the contract  
12 termination; and

13 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council has reviewed and approved the  
14 Community Health Services contract.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Council that  
16 it does authorize and request the Public Health Indian  
17 Health Service to contract with the Tohono O'Odham  
18 Nation under P. L. 93-638 regulations and procedures for  
19 the provision of services titled: Community Health  
20 Services.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the approved budget is subject to  
22 change once a decision is made on the Cost of Living  
23 (COLA) rate.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this contract will  
25 commence on October 1, 1988 through September 30, 1989  
26 unless extended by mutual agreement of both parties.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not  
28 fund or operate a program from which contracts are  
29 requested herewith which have not been negotiated and  
30 executed by the Indian Health Service prior to the start  
31 of the funding year.

32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Treasurer of the

1 Tohono O'Odham Nation are hereby authorized to negotiate  
2 and execute this contract and any amendments thereto for  
3 the duration of the contract, provided however, that any  
4 amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of  
5 this contract shall be submitted for further prior  
6 approval by this Council.


7 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
8 on the 20th. day of June, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum  
9 was present with a vote of 1,013.0 for; 143.5 against; 242.5  
10 not voting; and 241.0 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in  
11 the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution  
12 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham  
13 Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy  
14 Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,  
15 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
16 Stat. 984).


