

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Tohono O'Odham Training Services P. L. 99-570)

RES. NO. 157-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the  
2 Training Services Program for the Tohono O'Odham Nation  
3 as required by P. L. 99-570 under P. L. 93-638 contract  
4 with Public Health, Indian Health Services; and

5 WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and  
6 beneficial to the Tohono O'Odham Nation and its people;  
7 and

8 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Section 271.20 of the Federal Regulations  
9 requires that all proposals to recontract under P. L.  
10 93-638 be submitted to the Tohono O'Odham Council for  
11 approval at least 120 days prior to the contract  
12 termination; and

13 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does desire to recontract for  
14 provisions of these services during FY 1989; and

15 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council has reviewed and approved the  
16 Training Services Program contract.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
18 Council that it does authorize and request the Public  
19 Health, Indian Health Service to contract with the  
20 Tohono O'Odham Nation under P. L. 93-638 regulations and  
21 procedures for the provision of services titled:  
22 Training Services Program.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the approved budget is subject to  
24 change once a decision is made on the Cost of Living  
25 Allowance (COLA) rate.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this contract will  
27 commence on October 01, 1988 through September 30, 1989  
28 unless extended by mutual agreement of both parties.

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
30 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate  
31 the program from which contracts are requested herewith  
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1 which have not been negotiated and executed by the  
2 Indian Health Service prior to the start of the funding  
3 year.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a Training Plan and Schedule shall be  
5 submitted to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council in  
6 the July Session.

7 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
8 that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Treasurer of the  
9 Tohono O'odham Nation are hereby authorized to negotiate  
10 and execute this contract and any amendments thereto for  
11 the duration of the contract, provided however, that any  
12 amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of  
13 this contract shall be submitted for further prior  
14 approval by this Council.

15 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
16 on the 20th day of June, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum  
17 was present with a vote of 1,139.0 for; 202.0 against; 58.0  
18 not voting; and 241.0 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in  
19 the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution  
20 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham  
21 Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy  
22 Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,  
23 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
24 Stat. 984).
