

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tohono O'Odham Emergency Medical Services)

RES. NO. 158-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does not have an Emergency
2 Medical Services at its disposal; and

3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation lands are vast with its
4 population widely dispersed in over sixty (60) villages
5 through the reservation; and

6 WHEREAS, emergent medical care is a constant need in any
7 community but more so in rural community such as the
8 Tohono O'Odham Reservation; and

9 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Health Department along with the
10 Sells Service Unit is currently in the process of
11 designing a comprehensive EMS System to serve the
12 reservation under the supervision of the Tribal Health
13 Agency; and

14 WHEREAS, the Community Health Workers of the Tohono O'Odham
15 Health Department are responding to emergencies that
16 occur on the reservation; and

17 WHEREAS, the Community Health Workers are the staff designated
18 and trained as first responders to emergencies; and

19 WHEREAS, the Community Health Workers respond to emergencies with
20 minimal equipment; and

21 WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Health Services, Emergency
22 Medical Services and Health Care Facilities, Office of
23 Emergency Medical Services has submitted a Request for
24 proposal (RFP) for the funding of first responder
25 programs; and

26 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation, Tohono O'Odham Health
27 Department, is currently operating a first responder
28 program through its Community Health Division, Community
29 Health Branch.

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham
31 Legislative Council does hereby endorse the submittal of
32

1 the request for funding FY 1988-1989 for the Tohono
2 O'Odham Health Department (TOHD) Emergency First
3 Responder Program.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
5 that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Treasurer of the
6 Tohono O'Odham Nation are hereby authorized to negotiate
7 and execute this contract and any amendments thereto for
8 the duration of the contract, provided however, that any
9 amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of
10 this contract shall be submitted for further prior
11 approval by this Council.


12 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
13 on the 20th. day of June, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum
14 was present with a vote of 1,197.0 for; -0- against; 202.0
15 not voting; and 241.0 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in
16 the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution
17 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham
18 Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy
19 Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
20 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
21 Stat. 984).


