

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Accepting Grant Funds From The Arizona Humanities Council
& Authorizing The Development Of A Text Book
On Tohono O'Odham History)

RES. NO. 163-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation deems it important that its
2 membership, especially its Youth, be knowledgeable of
3 tribal history; and

4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Education Department through a
5 previous project have on record historical documents
6 that could be compiled into a text book on O'Odham
7 history; and

8 WHEREAS, the American West Center, University of Utah has agreed
9 to assist in the development of a history text; and

10 WHEREAS, the Arizona Humanities Council has approved funds to
11 develop this text book.


12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council does
13 hereby approve the receipt of grant funds in the amount
14 of \$9,165.00 from the Arizona Humanities Council.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that activities under the Project's Scope
16 of Work shall not be initiated until the Scope of Work
17 has been reviewed and approved by the Human Resources
18 Development Committee and the Cultural Preservation
19 Committee of the Legislature.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
21 Council will approve the final manuscript prior to
22 printing and/or publication and that the Tohono O'Odham
23 Nation shall retain and have ownership of all copyrights
24 to the text.

25 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
26 on the 20th. day of June, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum
27 was present with a vote of 1,314.0 for; -0- against; 85.0 not
28 voting; and 241.0 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
29 Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of
30 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
984).
