

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Tracy Highway Maintenance Camp Lease for  
Pisinemo District)

RES. NO. 173-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation entered into agreement with  
2 the Department of Transportation Highway Division, State  
3 of Arizona, on July 1, 1982 to lease the following  
4 described property, known as Tracy's Highway Maintenance  
5 Camp, to wit:

6 a 200' X 200' parcel of land lying 100' southerly of and  
7 at right angles to the center lane of State Highway 86,  
8 extending from Highway Engineer Station 1928 / 00 to  
9 Highway Engineer State 1930 / 00; and

10 WHEREAS, the Pisinemo District Council Resolution No. 3-86  
11 requesting for a renewal of Tracy's Maintenance Camp  
12 Lease, was tabled by Legislative Council Resolution No.  
13 07-87 citing more information needed; and

14 WHEREAS, the Pisinemo District Council and the State of Arizona's  
15 Department of Transportation have worked to comply with  
16 the necessary requirements with the Bureau of Indian  
17 Affairs (BIA) and with the Tohono O'Odham Nation's  
18 Administration and Accounting Department; and

19 WHEREAS, the Pisinemo District did submit Resolution No. 3-88  
20 requesting for support and passage by Legislative  
21 Council for a new ten (10) year lease agreement between  
22 the Tohono O'Odham Nation and Pisinemo District, with  
23 the State of Arizona.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham  
25 Legislative Council does hereby approve execution of a  
26 lease with the State of Arizona's Department of  
27 Transportation of the property known as Tracy's Highway  
28 Maintenance Camp for a period of ten (10) years,  
29 commencing July 1, 1986 to June 30, 1996, with the  
30 following payment schedule: From July 1, 1986 to June  
31 30, 1989 at an annual rental rate of \$1,000.00; and from  
32 July 1, 1989 to June 30, 1996 at an annual rental of  
\$2,000.00 payable to the Tohono O'Odham Nation and to be  
shared equally between the Tohono O'Odham Nation and the  
Pisinemo District.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE State's Department of

1           Transportation is to make a \$3,000 payment for July 01,  
2           1986 to June 30, 1989 to the Pisinemo District upon the  
3           approval of this lease; and

4 AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Pisinemo District Council is  
5           authorized to withdraw \$1,000 and deposit it in a  
6           liquid banking activity for youth related activities.

7 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
8 on the 5th day of July, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum was  
9 present with a vote of 1,455.5 for; -0- against; 184.5 not  
10 voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
11 Council by Section 1 (d) of Article VI of the Constitution of  
12 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation  
13 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
14 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,  
15 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.  
16 984).
