

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Multi-Health Complex Roof Repairs)

RES. NO. 175-88

1 WHEREAS, the Multi-Health Complex roof is in serious disrepair,  
2 and the roofing structure is defective; and  
3 WHEREAS, the structural defects as well as the roof membrane  
4 problem has been existent since initial construction;  
5 and  
6 WHEREAS, this problem has been previously identified and attempts  
7 have been made to resolve it without success; and  
8 WHEREAS, the Nation has allocated and expended considerable  
9 resources and funds in prior attempts to resolve this  
10 problem; and  
11 WHEREAS, the condition of disrepair has deteriorated to a point  
12 that it seriously jeopardizes the integrity of the  
13 structures and their utilization; and  
14 WHEREAS, continued utilization of the facilities are necessary to  
15 the effective and efficient operation of the Nation's  
16 Health Programs and to the health and welfare of the  
17 Nation's populace; and  
18 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Nation as well as the  
19 most cost effective alternative to effect repairs to the  
20 existing structures; and  
21 WHEREAS, the Nation's Research and Planning Office has been  
22 instrumental in researching and advocating resolution of  
23 this matter; and  
24 WHEREAS, the Research and Planning Department has experience and  
25 expertise in administering consultant and construction  
26 contracts.  
27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Nation allocates  
28 \$344,000.00 from the FY 1988 Reserve Funds to effect  
29 roofing and structural repairs to the Multi-Health  
30 Complex.  
31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Research and Planning Department  
32 and the Health and Human Services Committee of the

1 Nation's Legislature be delegated the responsibility of  
2 administering the solicitation and subsequent selection  
3 of a construction contract to effect such repairs.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Research and Planning Office be  
5 delegated the responsibility of construction contract  
6 administration.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Accounting Department, in the  
8 person of Mr. Dan Lansberry, Comptroller be delegated  
9 the responsibility of administering tribal funds  
10 allocated to this project.

11 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that any funds allocated but not expended  
12 for this activity shall be returned to the Nation's  
13 General Treasury.

14 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
15 on the 6th day of July, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum was  
16 present with a vote of 1,455.0 for; -0- against; 185.0 not  
17 voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
18 Council by Section 1 (d) of Article VI of the Constitution of  
19 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation  
20 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
21 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,  
22 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.  
23 984).
