

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Facilities Needs Assessment)

RES. NO. 176-88

1 WHEREAS, the existing buildings and facilities of the Nation are
2 inadequate to meet current and future projected needs;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, several programs and departments are leasing or
5 proposing to lease modular mobile office space; and

6 WHEREAS, other programs and departments are in need of more or
7 updated building space and do not have the resources to
8 acquire that space; and

9 WHEREAS, it is projected to be more beneficial and economical in
10 the long term to construct permanent, adequate
11 facilities; and

12 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Nation and the
13 Nation's populace to provide adequate facilities for
14 governmental functions; and

15 WHEREAS, the most effective and efficient methodology of
16 determining adequate provision of adequate facilities
17 would be to engage professional consultation in
18 conducting an analysis of current and projected needs.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Nation does allocate
20 \$20,000.00 from the FY 1988 Reserve Funds to conduct a
21 needs analysis and for the preparation of preliminary
22 architectural and engineering analysis and design of
23 such facilities.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Nation authorizes procuring a
25 contract for the provision of such services.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Research and Planning Department
27 shall be delegated the responsibility of administering
28 the consultant contract.

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Accounting Department in the
30 person of Mr. Dan Lansberry, Comptroller, be delegated
31 the responsibility of administering the Nation's funds
32 allocated toward this project.

1 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
2 on the 6th. day of July , 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum was
3 present with a vote of 1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not
4 voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
5 Council by Section 1 (d) of Article VI of the Constitution of
6 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
7 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
8 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
9 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
10 984).
