

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Papago Agency Reserve Land)

RES. NO. 178-88

1 WHEREAS, by the power vested in the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
2 Body to the extent of the Tohono O'Odham Nation to  
3 administer land and other public property, law,  
4 ordinance or resolution; and

5 WHEREAS, now before this Legislative Council is the Sells  
6 District Council resolution requesting restoration of  
7 all Papago Agency Reserve Land not currently in use by  
8 the Papago Agency, the current Reserve Lands encompasses  
9 380 acres plus 120 acres restored to the Nation, August  
10 13, 1982.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
12 Council that the Papago Agency Reserve Land not in use  
13 be restored back to the Sells District and the Tohono  
14 O'Odham Nation.

15 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
16 on the 6th. day of July, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum was  
17 present with a vote of 820.5 for; 432.0 against; 387.5 not  
18 voting; and 06 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
19 Council by Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution  
20 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham  
21 Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy  
22 Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,  
23 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
24 Stat. 984).
