

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL  
(Referring Schuk Toak Predesign Contract No. 8-CS-32-00380  
to the Water Resources Committee)

LEGIS. ORDER NO. 183-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the  
2 Schuk Toak Predesign Program under a P. L. 93-638  
3 contract with the Bureau of Reclamation; and

4 WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels  
5 of the contract shall be submitted for review and  
6 approval by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council; and

7 WHEREAS, the amendment has been reviewed by the Tohono O'Odham  
8 Legislative Council and have raised their concerns and  
9 questions on the type of assessment used to determine  
10 cost for the deliverables under the contract.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
12 Council that the Schuk Toak Predesign Contract No. 8-CS-  
13 32-00380 amendment is referred back to the Water  
14 Resources Committee for further review and clarification  
15 on how the cost were assessed for the deliverables under  
16 the contract.

17 The foregoing Legislative Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham  
18 Council on the 7th. day of July, 1988 at a meeting at which a  
19 quorum was present with a vote of 1,071.5 for; 371.0 against;  
20 197.5 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested  
21 in the Council by Section 1(b) of Article VI of the  
22 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
23 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting  
24 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March  
25 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
26 Stat. 984).
