10	WHEREAS,	after consideration of the three proposed options and
11		the District's Resolution No. 06-88, the Tohono O'Odham
12		Legislative Council passed its Resolution No. 62-88,
13		wherein it authorized the Water Resources Committee, Sif
14		Oidak District Council, and the Nation's Attorney to
15		meet with the City of Tucson to begin discussion on
16		Option B as supported by the Sif Oidak District Council
17		per its Resolution No. 06-88; and
18	WHEREAS,	on April the 27th, 1988 the Legislative Council did
19		accept a written offer from the City of Tucson to lease
20		8000 acre feet of C.A.P. water allocated to the Chuichu
21		area of the Sif Oidak District, provided that the City
22		of Tucson agrees to eliminate the right to assign its
23		rights and obligations under the agreement to any
24		C.A.P. subcontractor as contained in paragraph 6 of the
25		City of Tucson's offer; and
26		during the following negotiations with the City of
27	-	Tucson and the drafting of the necessary agreements, the

Tucson and the drafting of the necessary agreements, the City of Tucson insisted on a provision that would restrict the Nation from taxing the water leased to the City, which provision is not acceptable to the Nation; and

due to the short period of time remaining in this WHEREAS, 1 session of Congress which limits the time necessary to 2 continue negotiating with the City of Tucson on this 3 issue, this Legislature believes it to be in the best 4 interest of the Nation and the Sif Oidak District that 5 the water settlement legislation for the Chuichu area of 6 the Sif Oidak District now pending before Congress 7 (subject to making the necessary amendments to authorize 8 the leasing of water to the City of Tucson) be delayed 9 to the next session of Congress in 1989. 10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham 11 Legislative Council does hereby request Congress to 12 delay any further action on the Chuichu Water Settlement 13 Bill for this session of Congress so as to provide the 14 Nation with the necessary time to continue its

negotiations with the City of Tucson or if said negotiations are unsuccessful, to decide on other options that might be acceptable to Congress.
