2 WHEREAS, the "Future Leaders of the Tohono O'Odham Nation" Group  
3 made a presentation to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
4 Council about their attendance and participation with  
5 the United National Indian Tribal Youth Conference held  
6 in Washington, D.C. on June 25-29, 1988; and


7 WHEREAS, part of their presentation included the youth discussion  
8 on drug and alcohol which they identified as the number  
9 one problem facing the Tohono O'Odham Nation; and

10 WHEREAS, a list of solutions, barriers, and negative images seen  
11 in our communities were submitted which the Tohono  
12 O'Odham Legislative Council decided to refer to the  
13 appropriate committees for review and a report back to  
14 the Council for action.


15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
16 Council that the list of solutions, barriers and  
17 negative images submitted is hereby referred to the  
18 appropriate committees for review and a report back to  
19 the Council for action.

20 The foregoing Legislative Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham  
21 Council on the 1st. day of August, 1988 at a meeting at which a  
22 quorum was present with a vote of 1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0-  
23 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
24 Council by Section 1(b) of Article VI of the Constitution of  
25 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation  
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,  
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.  
984).
