

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Request for transfer of Government Building)

RES. NO. 198-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Judiciary was informed of the Bureau
2 of Indian Affairs' intent to demolish a dormitory
3 building at the Santa Rosa Boarding School; and

4 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Education Department,
5 advised the Chief Judge of this impending action and
6 offered the transfer and use of the building to the
7 Judiciary; and

8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Judiciary, by and through the Court
9 Administrator has inspected the building and found the
10 setting and space suitable for purposes proposed by the
11 Judiciary; and

12 WHEREAS, minor renovation and repair will be necessary to
13 accommodate the programs and services to be housed
14 within the buildings; and

15 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Judiciary is interested in obtaining
16 the building and has forwarded a letter to the Bureau of
17 Indian Affairs advising of this interest; and

18 WHEREAS, a resolution from the Legislative Council in support of
19 the Judiciary's request will be required by the Bureau
20 of Indian Affairs.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
22 Council that it does hereby support the transfer of the
23 Santa Rosa Boarding School dormitory to the Tohono
24 O'Odham Nation for use in housing the programs of the
25 Judiciary Branch but also make it available to other
26 Programs to use with preference to the Educational
27 Programs.

28 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
29 on the 2nd. day of August, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum
30 was present with a vote of 1,411.5 for; 100.5 against; 128.0
31 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
32 Council by Section 1 (c)(4) of Article VI of the Constitution
of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham
Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy
Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
Stat. 984).
