The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 2nd. day of August , 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,411.5 for; 100.5 against; <u>128.0</u> not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (c)(4) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, on March 6, 18, 1934 (48 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June Stat. 984).
