

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authority to apply for the Child Care Food Program)

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Human Service Department is presently
2 providing meals and snacks for children who attend the
3 Day Care Centers at Baboquivari High School and Tohono
4 O'Odham High School; and

5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Human Service Department does desire
6 to provide nutritionally adequate meals and snacks for
7 the children at the day care; and

8 WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Education has programs
9 available which would aid in providing nutritionally
10 adequate meals for the children at the two day care
11 centers; and

12 WHEREAS, it would be beneficial for the Tohono O'Odham Human
13 Service Department to apply for the Child Care Food
14 Program with the Arizona Department of Education.


15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
16 Council that it does authorize and request the Tohono
17 O'Odham Human Service Department to apply for the Child
18 Care Food Program with the Arizona Department of
19 Education.

21 on the 2nd day of August, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum
22 was present with a vote of 1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not
23 voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
24 Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of
25 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
26 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
27 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
28 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
29 984).
