

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Cultural Preservation Committee request for support
with its recommended action)

RES. NO. 204-88

1 WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation Committee submitted their
2 report to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
3 regarding an employee of the Casa Grande Police
4 Department who is a member of the Tohono O'Odham Nation
5 and has requested the assistance of the Tohono O'Odham
6 Nation for discriminatory action taken by her
7 Supervisor by ordering her to take a psychiatric
8 evaluation because she sought the aid of a Medicine Man;
9 and


10 WHEREAS, the Committee through its follow-up on the individual
11 complaint determined that the action by the Chief of
12 Police is a direct attack on the Tohono O'Odham Nation's
13 culture and its traditional beliefs; and

14 WHEREAS, the Committee is now seeking the support of the Tohono
15 O'Odham Legislative Council to follow through with the
16 actions recommended to the Council which is incorporated
17 in the report.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
19 Council that the follow-up actions recommended by the
20 Cultural Preservation Committee is hereby supported and
21 approved.

23 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
24 on the 4th. day of August, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum
25 was present with a vote of 1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not
26 voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
27 Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitution of
the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
984).
