- (2) a letter should be sent to the Civil Rights Commission regarding the action of the EEOC.
- (3) the cost of this action be absorbed by the Nation.
- (4) a letter be sent to the Casa Grande Chief of Police recommending that he make an apology in letter form or by newspaper.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Cultural Preservation Committee come back and update the Council and if the meeting with the City of Casa Grande does not go well then the alternative actions should be taken as outlined in the handout.

The foregoing resolution was DEFEATED by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 4th. day of August , 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 241.5 for; 1,113.5 against; 285.0 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
