

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Alternative Actions regarding the Casa Grande
Police Department)

RES. NO. 205-88

1 WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation Committee did make
2 recommendations to the Council regarding the treatment
3 of one of our tribal members employed by the City of
4 Casa Grande in the Police Department; and

5 WHEREAS, alternative actions need to be considered to follow up
6 on this matter by the Cultural Preservation Committee


7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
8 Council that:

- 10 (1) the Tribal Attorney be used as a resource person
and if this is not workable than an Indian Attorney
11 be used.
 - 12 (2) a letter should be sent to the Civil Rights
Commission regarding the action of the EEOC.
 - 13 (3) the cost of this action be absorbed by the Nation.
 - 14 (4) a letter be sent to the Casa Grande Chief of Police
15 recommending that he make an apology in letter form
or by newspaper.


16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Cultural Preservation Committee
17 come back and update the Council and if the meeting with
18 the City of Casa Grande does not go well then the
19 alternative actions should be taken as outlined in the
20 handout.

21 The foregoing resolution was DEFEATED by the Tohono O'odham
22 Council on the 4th. day of August, 1988 at a meeting at which a
quorum was present with a vote of 241.5 for; 1,113.5 against;
23 285.0 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested
in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the
24 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting
25 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March
6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
26 Stat. 984).


