

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Renewal of Pima County College District Agreement)

RES. NO. 210-88

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council did by Resolution No. 83-87,
2 approve the execution on behalf of the Tohono O'odham
3 Nation of an Intergovernmental Agreement dated April 9,
4 1987, with the Pima Community College District which
5 authorizes the various Departments of the Nation which
6 have funds available therefor to enter into and execute
7 separate contracts, and any amendments thereto, for
8 educational and counseling services; and


9 WHEREAS, the Agreement expired on June 30, 1987, and was renewed
10 for an additional 12 month period through June 30, 1988;
11 and

12 WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the Nation that the Agreement
13 again be renewed.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council approves renewal
15 of the original Agreement dated April 9, 1987, for the
16 period of July 1, 1988, to June 30, 1989, and does
17 hereby authorize and direct the Chairman of the Nation
18 to execute the attached Renewal of Agreement on behalf
19 of the Nation.

20 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
21 on the 30th day of August, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum
22 was present with a vote of 1,577.0 for; -0- against; 63.0 not
23 voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
24 Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of
the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
984).




