WHEREAS, the Legislative Council did by Resolution No. 83-87, approve the execution on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation of an Intergovernmental Agreement dated April 9, 1987, with the Pima Community College District which authorizes the various Departments of the Nation which have funds available therefor to enter into and execute separate contracts, and any amendments thereto, for educational and counseling services; and

whereas, the Agreement expired on June 30, 1987, and was renewed for an additional 12 month period through June 30, 1988; and

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the Nation that the Agreement again be renewed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council approves renewal of the original Agreement dated April 9, 1987, for the period of July 1, 1988, to June 30, 1989, and does hereby authorize and direct the Chairman of the Nation to execute the attached Renewal of Agreement on behalf of the Nation.

The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 30th day of August, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,577.0 for; -0- against; 63.0 not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
