WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation by and through its representatives have proceeded, in good faith, to meet with the Indian Health Service and the Solicitors Office to settle differences cited in the recision letter; and WHEREAS, this meeting did not result in a negotiated settlement; and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the Tohono O'odham Nation that the recision of the Tohono O'odham Psychological Services contract on the grounds of "threat to life" lacks merit and that, therefore, the recision is in direct conflict with intent and spirit of the "Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act, P.L. 93-638."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'odham

Legislative Council hereby authorizes the Chairman of
the Nation and the Chairperson of the Health and Human

Services Committee to pursue an appeal on the recision
of the Tohono O'odham Psychological Services contract by

Indian Health Service.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that since the Tohono O'odham Nation at the request of the IHS did continue its appeal to allow for the settlement meeting, the Chairman of the Nation and the Chairperson of Health and Human Services is directed to seek an appeal date no less than ten days after written notification to IHS of the Nation's intent to pursue its appeal.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the current operation of the Tohono
O'odham Psychological Services be maintained in place as
a program of the Nation to provide services.
