

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Changing name of the Tohono O'Odham Human Service
Department to Tohono O'Odham Social Service Department)

RES. NO. 225-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Human Service Department was created
2 in 1983 when the Tohono O'Odham Nation contracted for
3 the Bureau's Social Service Program under P. L. 93-638;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, the name "Human Services" connotes a larger sphere of
6 services than the Tohono O'Odham Human Service
7 Department provides; and

8 WHEREAS, the services provided by the Tohono O'Odham Human
9 Service Department more closely fits the definition of
10 Social Services than Human Services; and

11 WHEREAS, the community has a clearer understanding of the concept
12 of Social Services as opposed to Human Services.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the name Tohono O'Odham Human
14 Service Department be changed to Tohono O'Odham Social
15 Service Department to be representative of the services
16 being provided by the Human Service Program.


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18 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
19 on the 7th day of September, 1988 at a meeting at which a
20 quorum was present with a vote of 1,492.0 for; -0- against;
21 148.0 not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested
22 in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the
23 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
24 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting
25 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March
26 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
27 Stat. 984).
