

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approval of the Public Water Systems Program  
Grant Application)

RES. NO. 233-88

1 WHEREAS, the Public Water Systems Program (PWSP) has assisted the  
2 Environmental Protection Agency in monitoring the SDWA  
3 Compliance of Tohono O'Odham Nation public water  
4 systems; and

5 WHEREAS, funding for FY '88 has become available to the Tohono  
6 O'Odham Nation to contract; and

7 WHEREAS, the funding will enable the Public Water Systems Program  
8 to continue its monitoring and the other activities  
9 outlined in the attached Work Plan to ensure Safe  
10 Drinking Water Act compliance of Tohono O'Odham Public  
11 Water Systems.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that it  
13 hereby approves the Environmental Protection Agency  
14 Grant Application in the sum of \$15,000.00

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
16 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate  
17 the program in the interim while negotiations are still  
18 being conducted and no executed grant has been awarded  
19 by the Environmental Protection Agency.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
21 that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Treasurer of the  
22 Tohono O'Odham Nation are hereby authorized to negotiate  
23 and execute this grant and any amendments thereto for  
24 the duration of the grant, provided however, that any  
25 amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of  
26 this contract shall be submitted for further prior  
27 approval by this Council.

29 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
30 on the 7th. day of September, 1988 at a meeting at which a  
31 quorum was present with a vote of 1,230.0 for; -0- against;  
32 241.0 not voting; and 169.0 absent, pursuant to the powers  
vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the  
Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting  
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March  
6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
Stat. 984).
