

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Support for Establishment of Program of
Community Oriented Primary Care)

RES. NO. 237-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation, Tohono O'Odham Health Board,
2 has adopted a policy of a redesign of the Health
3 Department to reflect a Community Oriented Primary Care
4 (COPC) methodology of delivery of health services; and

5 WHEREAS, it is the hope of the Health Board and the Health
6 Department that through the COPC methodology health
7 care services can be accessible, acceptable,
8 comprehensive, coordinated, and continuous to the
9 O'Odham; and

10 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Health Department has geared its
11 programs and future health care delivery system around
12 the COPC methodology; and

13 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Health Department constantly seeks
14 support for the successful implementation and completion
15 of the COPC health services delivery; and

16 WHEREAS, the National Rural Health Association, Hospital Research
17 and Education Trust has submitted a Request for Proposal
18 (RFP) to provide technical assistance as well as funding
19 to support the department in its personnel needs in the
20 implementation of the COPC methodology service delivery
21 program; and

22 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Health Board and the Legislative
23 Health and Human Services Committee have reviewed the
24 proposal and budget for this proposal and do endorse its
25 submittal.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
27 Council that it does hereby support and endorse the
28 submittal of the proposal for the "Support for
29 Establishment of a Program of Community Oriented Primary
30 Care."
