

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Authorizing Extension of Judicial Services  
Contract No. H50C14208054)

RES. NO. 239-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council did authorize the  
2 submission of a P. L. 93-638 recontract application for  
3 Judicial Services by Resolution No. 103-88 for FY '89;  
4 and

5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Judiciary has learned from the Bureau  
6 of Indian Affairs that the amount available for  
7 recontract will not include the \$200,000.00 increase  
8 provided by Congress during FY '88; and

9 WHEREAS, \$151,516.00 of the FY '88 congressional appropriation  
10 was intended to be used for renovation and addition of a  
11 second courtroom and office space for judges; and

12 WHEREAS, the unavailability of the FY '88 congressional  
13 appropriation in FY '89 will result in staff and  
14 services being curtailed; and

15 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Judiciary has decided to postpone the  
16 renovation project and instead budget the \$151,516.00 to  
17 supplement the FY '89 base to continue services and  
18 staff; and

19 WHEREAS, the most expedient and effective means of spending these  
20 funds is through an extension of the FY '88 Judicial  
21 Services contract, which is allowed by federal  
22 contracting regulations; and

23 WHEREAS, an extension of the existing FY '88 Judicial Services  
24 contract will enable the Tohono O'Odham Judiciary to  
25 provide continuity in services and staff; and

26 WHEREAS, the recontract application submitted for FY '89 is  
27 hereby withdrawn to allow an extension of the existing  
28 FY '88 contract; and


29 WHEREAS, FY '89 Judicial Services funds in the amount of  
30 \$145,000.00 will be added to the existing contract by a  
31 modification when those funds are available and  
32 authorized to be spent by FY '89 congressional  
appropriations.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
2 Council that it hereby authorizes and requests the  
3 Bureau of Indian Affairs to approve the attached budget  
4 modification and to extend the existing Judicial  
5 Services Contract No. H50C14208054 through March 31,  
6 1989.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman or  
8 Treasurer of the Tohono O'Odham Nation are hereby  
9 authorized to negotiate and execute this contract and  
10 any amendments thereto for the duration of the contract,  
11 provided however, that any amendments affecting the  
12 funding or funding levels of this contract shall be  
13 submitted for further prior approval by this Council.


14 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
15 on the 8th day of September, 1988 at a meeting at which a  
16 quorum was present with a vote of 1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0-  
17 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
18 Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of  
19 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation  
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,  
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.  
984).
