

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL  
(Amending Council Agenda to include Executive Office's  
Budget Appeal)

LEGIS. ORDER NO. 255-88

1 WHEREAS, during the review of the Tohono O'odham Nation's  
2 budgets for FY '89, program directors stated their  
3 disapproval of the allocations made to their programs;  
4 and

5 WHEREAS, on September 23, 1988, the Legislative Council continued  
6 to address the Tohono O'odham Nation's Budget for FY  
7 '89; and

8 WHEREAS, the agenda included, for Council consideration, the  
9 following budget appeals: 1) Education Department/  
10 Education Committee; 2) Rodeo & Fair Committee; 3)  
11 Research & Planning Department; 4) Enrollment Program;  
12 5) Legislative Branch; 6) Judicial Branch; and

13 WHEREAS, a request was made by the Nation's Executive Office to  
14 add a budget appeal from the Executive Office to the  
15 agenda.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham  
17 Legislative Council hereby amends its agenda established  
18 for September 23, 1988, to include a budget appeal from  
19 the Nation's Executive Office.

20 The foregoing ORDER was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on  
21 the 23rd day of September, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum  
22 was present with a vote of 1,081.0 for; 320.0 against; 238.5 not  
23 voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
24 Council by Section 1(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of  
25 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation  
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,  
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.  
984).
