

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Amending Council Agenda to include Early Childhood
Budget Appeal)

2 WHEREAS, during the review of the Tohono O'odham Nation's
3 budgets for FY '89, program directors stated their
4 disapproval of the allocations made to their programs;
5 and

6 WHEREAS, on September 23, 1988, the Legislative Council continued
7 to address the Tohono O'odham Nation's Budget for FY
8 '89; and

9 WHEREAS, the agenda included, for Council consideration, the
10 following budget appeals: 1) Education Department/
11 Education Committee; 2) Rodeo & Fair Committee; 3)
12 Research & Planning Department; 4) Enrollment Program;
13 5) Legislative Branch; 6) Judicial Branch; and

14 WHEREAS, by Legislative Order No. 255-88, the Nation's Executive
15 Office budget appeal was included for Council
16 consideration; and

17 WHEREAS, the Director of the Education Department requested that
18 the Early Childhood Program budget appeal be considered
19 with Education Department's appealed budget.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham
21 Legislative Council hereby further amends its agenda
22 established for September 23, 1988, to include a budget
23 appeal from the Nation's Early Childhood Program.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Early Childhood Program's budget
25 appeal be considered along with the Education
26 Department's budget appeal.

27 The foregoing ORDER was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on
28 the 23rd day of September, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum
29 was present with a vote of 1,328.5 for; -0- against; 311.5 not
30 voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
31 Council by Section 1(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the
32 Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
984).


