RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Public Water Systems Program Budget FY '88-89)

2 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council did hear a request by the Public  
3 Water Supply Supervision Program (PWSSP) to change the  
4 title of the program to the Public Water Systems Program  
5 (PWSP); and

6 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council on September 27, 1988 reviewed  
7 the proposed Public Water Systems Program budget in the  
8 amount of \$40,585.00; and

9 WHEREAS, the appropriate Committees did review the proposed  
10 budget and have referred it to the Legislative Council  
11 for their immediate action; and

12 WHEREAS, the Water Resources Committee has recommended that the  
13 decision to transfer the Nation's operation of the  
14 public water systems which are not currently under PTUA  
15 to the Utility be delayed until March 31, 1989 and that  
16 the collection of water samples and payment for test  
17 analyses by PWSP will be extended until March 31, 1989;  
18 and

19 WHEREAS, the intent of the proposal is to fulfill the Tohono  
20 O'odham Nation objective to comply with the Safe  
21 Drinking Water Act and to assume the regulatory and  
22 enforcement role presently administered by EPA.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
24 Council that it hereby approves the Public Water Systems  
25 Program budget in the amount of \$40,585.00 effective  
26 October 1, 1988 to September 30, 1989.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funds to cover the budget come  
28 from the Tohono O'odham Water Trust Fund.

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
30 that the Water Resources Committee is hereby directed to  
31 present a report on the take-over of the public water  
32 systems.
