

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Establishing September 29, 1988 for Special Council Meeting)

LEGIS. ORDER NO. 280-88

1 WHEREAS, on September 26, 1988, the Tohono O'odham Legislative
2 Council adopted Resolution No. 264-88, "Adoption of
3 Tohono O'odham Nation's FY '89 Budget including
4 Projected Revenues and Committee Recommendations," and
5 presented the same to the Executive Branch of the
6 Nation; and

7 WHEREAS, on September 27, 1988 the Tohono O'odham Legislative
8 Council, by Legislative Order No. 278-88 "Amending
9 Council Agenda - September 27, 1988," agreed to include
10 the anticipated veto of Resolution No. 264-88 on the
11 agenda for Council consideration; and

12 WHEREAS, the Executive Office has informed the Legislative Office
13 that the Chairman does not intend to return Resolution
14 No. 264-88 to the Legislative Branch today; and

15 WHEREAS, the Nation's Chairman may exercise his full 48 hour
16 review of Resolution No. 264-88; and

17 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council would like to be prepared to
18 address the anticipated veto of Resolution No. 264-88.

19 WHEREAS, it was suggested to meet on September 29, 1988 to
20 address the anticipated veto of Resolution No. 264-88.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham
22 Legislative Council hereby reconvenes on Thursday,
23 September 29, 1988, to address the anticipated veto of
24 Resolution No. 264-88, "Adoption of Tohono O'odham
25 Nation's Fy '89 Budget including Projected Revenues and
26 Committee Recommendations."

27 The foregoing ORDER was PASSED by the Tohono O'odham Council on
28 the 27th. day of September, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum
29 was present with a vote of 1,114.5 for; 116.5 against; 281.0
30 not voting; and 128.0 (08) absent, pursuant to the powers vested
31 in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the
32 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March
6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
Stat. 984).


