

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing Payroll Advances for the 51st Annual Rodeo & Fair)

RES. NO. 291-88

1 WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer did inform the Budget &
2 Finance Committee of advance checks being requested for
3 the 51st Annual Rodeo & Fair; and

4 WHEREAS, the Budget & Finance Committee did discuss this matter
5 and denied the request; and


6 WHEREAS, the Legislative Chairperson did appeal this decision to
7 the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council; and

8 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council supported the Rodeo & Fair and
9 have in the past allowed such advances.


10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham
11 Legislative Council does hereby waive the interim policy
12 developed by the Budget & Finance Committee regarding
13 payroll advances and authorizes a payroll advance for
14 all employees of the Tohono O'Odham Nation for the 51st
15 Annual Rodeo & Fair occurring in this fiscal year.

16 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
17 on the 19th day of October, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum
18 was present with a vote of 1,313.0 for; 126.0 against; 201.0
19 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
20 Council by Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of
21 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
22 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
23 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
24 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
25 984).
