

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Continued Opposition to BIA/IHS Memorandum of Agreement
Establishing Child Protection Teams)

RES. NO. 292-88

1 WHEREAS, the Assistant Secretary of Indian Affairs and the
2 Director of Indian Health Service issued a mandate for
3 all Bureau and Tribally contracted Social Service
4 Programs to establish Child Protection Teams; and

5 WHEREAS, the Assistant Secretary of Indian Affairs and the
6 Director of Indian Health Services exceeded their
7 authority in issuing the mandate; and

8 WHEREAS, the Child Protection Team must be included in all P. L.
9 93-638 Social Service contracts; and

10 WHEREAS, it is within the realm of Tribal sovereignty to
11 determine if the concept of Child Protection Teams are
12 to be a part of Child Protective Services; and

13 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Health and Social Service Legislative
14 Committee has reviewed the attached position paper and
15 recommends to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council to
16 again seek endorsement and support from the National
17 Congress of American Indians (NCAI); and

18 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council sought and
19 received support on this issue at the National Congress
20 of American Indians (NCAI) in 1987; and the Bureau of
21 Indian Affairs has chosen to disregard the position of
22 the Tohono O'Odham Nation and to continue in the
23 implementation of the provisions of the Memorandum of
24 Agreement; and

25 WHEREAS, the efforts of this Bureau policy is not limited to the
26 Tohono O'Odham Nation but affects all tribes who
27 contract for programs under P. L. 93-638.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham
29 Legislative Council continues in its resolution to
30 oppose the mandates of the Memorandum of Agreement
31 establishing Child Protection Teams.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
2 Council continues to seek the support of the National
3 Congress of American Indians on this issue.


5 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
6 on the 19th. day of October, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum
7 was present with a vote of 1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not
8 voting; and 04 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
9 Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of
10 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
11 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
12 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
13 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
14 984).
