

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Opposition to the Bureau's Method of Quality Control)

RES. NO. 293-88

1 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Division of Social  
2 Service, Central Office, issued a directive to all  
3 Bureau and Tribally contracted Social Service Programs  
4 to participate in a Bureau Wide Quality Control effort  
5 conducted in August, 1988; and

6 WHEREAS, any Quality Control of Tribally contracted Social  
7 Service Programs shall be based on the 25 CFR part 20 as  
8 it relates to eligibility determination,  
9 redetermination, waivers, suspension, terminations and  
10 grant amounts and that tribe's program manuals; and

11 WHEREAS, any Bureau-Wide Quality Control effort which does not  
12 include Tribal input into the design is violating the  
13 principal of Self-Determination; and

14 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation supports the concept of  
15 Quality Control reviews conducted at Area or Agency  
16 level; and

17 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Health and Social Service Legislative  
18 Committee has reviewed the attached position paper and  
19 recommends to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council to  
20 seek endorsement and support from the National Congress  
21 of American Indians (NCAI).

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham  
23 Legislative Council directs the Tohono O'Odham Social  
24 Service Program not to participate in any Bureau Quality  
25 Control Reviews which are not based solely on the 25 CFR  
26 Part 20 and have not had any input from the Nation.


27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
28 Council does endorse this Resolution in opposition to  
29 the Bureau's method of designing and conducting Quality  
30 Control Reviews and seeks the support of the National  
31 Congress of American Indians on this matter.

32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation opposes any  
amendments to the 25 CFR to impose the Quality Control


initiative being sanctioned by the Bureau of Indian Affairs and seeks the support of the National Congress of American Indians (NAI) in this effort.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 19th. day of October, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,535.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 105.0 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
