RES. NO. <u>293-88</u> WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Division of Social Service, Central Office, issued a directive to all Bureau and Tribally contracted Social Service Programs to participate in a Bureau Wide Quality Control effort conducted in August, 1988; and

WHEREAS, any Bureau-Wide Quality Control effort which does not include Tribal input into the design is violating the principal of Self-Determination; and

14 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation supports the concept of 15 Quality Control reviews conducted at Area or Agency 16 level; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Health and Social Service Legislative Committee has reviewed the attached position paper and recommends to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council to seek endorsement and support from the National Congress of American Indians (NCAI).

the Tohono O'Odham that THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED NOW, 22Legislative Council directs the Tohono O'Odham Social 23Service Program not to participate in any Bureau Quality 24 Control Reviews which are not based solely on the 25 CFR 25Part 20 and have not had any input from the Nation. 26

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does endorse this Resolution in opposition to the Bureau's method of designing and conducting Quality Control Reviews and seeks the support of the National Congress of American Indians on this matter.
