RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Supporting Strong NCAI Housing Position and Paper)

RES. NO. 296-88

WHEREAS, the National Indian Housing Council has prepared a Position Paper on Indian Housing needs, utilizing the 1987 Indian Housing Survey which was conducted by the Bureau of Indian Affairs and which further indicated that there was an increase of housing needs in the amount of 30,000 new/or substantially rehabilitated homes as compared to the 1970 survey; and

WHEREAS, both surveys demonstrates the serious failing of the federal government to meet the shortfall of Indian Housing needs and this is further supported by the Congressional Appropriations, which showed that the 1980 appropriation went, in 1980, from 848 million to 148 million in 1988, a decrease of \$700,000,000; and

whereas, the Tohono O'Odham Nation and its Housing Committee supports the National Indian Housing Council in its Demonstration Position Paper which reflects housing needs on a national level in Indian country.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation urges the National Congress of American Indians organization to lobby Congress for additional annual appropriation of funding to address and meet the American Indian Housing needs and also to urge Congress to develop new ways for Indian families to obtain financing for new construction

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 19th. day of October, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
