RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (NCAI Support on Tohono O'Odham Psychological Services Reassumption Appeal)

RES. NO. 299-88

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has operated a Mental Health Program, including a Psychological Service Component, for the past 15 years, in part pursuant to a self-determination act contract with the Indian Health Service; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is committed to the development of its Mental Health Program in a way that not only will provide for the needs of its citizens but also will serve as a model for other Indian Tribes and Nations; and

WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service has engaged in actions that the Nation believes were intended to frustrate the Nation in the performance of its contract; and

WHEREAS, Indian Health Services has reassumed the Psychological Services Component of the contract, without compliance with procedures required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the National Congress of American Indians (NCAI) at its 45th Annual Convention, after due consideration by the appropriate committees, that:

- NCAI supports the Tohono O'Odham Nation in its appeal of the reassumption of the Psychological Service component of its Mental Health Program contract; and
- 2. NCAI supports the Tohono O'Odham Nation in its efforts to obtain a hearing on its appeal that complies with the requirements of the Administrative Procedure Act.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 19th. day of October, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
