

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Proceed in Closed Session with Exceptions)

LEGIS. ORDER NO. 319-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council held a Special
2 Meeting on November 10, 1988 to discuss education; and

3 WHEREAS, there were concerns that general discussions may lead to
4 issues personnel in nature and should be discussed in
5 closed session.

26 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of
27 the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the
28 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the
29 Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations)
30 on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
31 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
