

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Recommendations to U.S. Congress concerning Anti Drug Abuse  
Funding to Tohono O'odham Nation Police)

RES. NO. 32-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council recognizes that  
2 alcohol and drug abuse is a severe health and social  
3 problem facing the Tohono O'odham; and

4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council further  
5 recognizes that the importation of illegal narcotics  
6 from Mexico is a major contributory factor in our  
7 overall narcotics problem; and

8 WHEREAS, the "Anti Drug Abuse Act of 1986," provided for a  
9 \$500,000.00 allocation Tohono O'odham Law Enforcement  
10 for fiscal years 1987, 1988 and 1989 for the  
11 enforcement, investigation, interdiction and eradication  
12 of narcotics on the Reservation; and

13 WHEREAS, the appropriation for FY 1987 did not reach the Reser-  
14 vation through the Bureau of Indian Affairs until mid-  
15 June of 1987 and no appropriation was made to the Nation  
16 for FY 1988 due to unencumbered monies from the previous  
17 fiscal year and FY 1987 monies will be totally expended  
18 during FY 1988; and

19 WHEREAS, the appropriation of these monies is essential to the  
20 continued efforts of the Nation in narcotics enforcement  
21 during FY 1989 and further into the future.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
23 Council that it requests that the United States Congress  
24 continue to support the efforts of the Tohono O'odham  
25 Police Department by funding the narcotics enforcement  
26 unit for fiscal year 1989.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
28 Council urges that the yearly allocation for narcotics  
29 enforcement, investigation, interdiction and  
30 eradication be made a permanent part of the Law  
31 Enforcement base funding and a part of the P.L. 93-638  
32 contract.

1 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
2 on the 19th day of February, 1988, at a meeting at which a quorum  
3 was present with a vote of 1,581.5 for; -0- against; 58.5 not  
4 voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
5 Council by Section 1(c)(2) & (f) of Article IV of the  
6 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
7 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting  
8 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March  
9 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
10 Stat. 984).
