- WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council recognizes that alcohol and drug abuse is a severe health and social problem facing the Tohono O'odham; and
- WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council further recognizes that the importation of illegal narcotics from Mexico is a major contributory factor in our overall narcotics problem; and
- whereas, the "Anti Drug Abuse Act of 1986," provided for a \$500,000.00 allocation Tohono O'odham Law Enforcement for fiscal years 1987, 1988 and 1989 for the enforcement, investigation, interdiction and eradication of narcotics on the Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the appropriation for FY 1987 did not reach the Reservation through the Bureau of Indian Affairs until mid-June of 1987 and no appropriation was made to the Nation for FY 1988 due to unencumbered monies from the previous fiscal year and FY 1987 monies will be totally expended during FY 1988; and
- WHEREAS, the appropriation of these monies is essential to the continued efforts of the Nation in narcotics enforcement during FY 1989 and further into the future.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it requests that the United States Congress continue to support the efforts of the Tohono O'odham Police Department by funding the narcotics enforcement unit for fiscal year 1989.
- FURTHER RESOLVED that the BE IT Tohono O'odham Legislative Council urges that the yearly allocation for narcotics enforcement, investigation, interdiction and eradication be made a permanent part of the Law Enforcement base funding and a part of the P.L. 93-638 contract.
