

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appointing Planning of New Institutions Coordinator)

RES. NO. 342-88

1 WHEREAS, P. L. 99-570, the Omnibus Drug Enforcement, Education
2 and Control Act, Title IV, Subtitle C, cited as the
3 Indian Alcohol and Substance Abuse Prevention and
4 Treatment Act of 1986, authorized the construction or
5 renovation of new or existing juvenile detention and
6 rehabilitation center to facilitate the purposes of the
7 Act; and

8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Judiciary, Juvenile Division made
9 application for the construction of a new juvenile
10 facility which will accommodate the multi-faceted
11 rehabilitation programs proposed to treat and
12 rehabilitate O'Odham youth with alcohol/drug/chemical
13 abuse problems; and

14 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has notified the Tohono
15 O'Odham Nation of its selection as one of ten tribes
16 designated to participate in the program entitled PONI
17 (Planning of New Institutions) to prepare for the
18 construction of a new juvenile facility; and

19 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs is requiring the formal
20 appointment of a representative to coordinate the
21 preparatory activities; and

22 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council, by Resolution No. 71-88,
23 approved the PONI application including the
24 establishment of an advisory group as required by the
25 PONI regulations; and


26 WHEREAS, the Court Administrator, Max Chavez, was designated as
27 the coordinator of the project and assumed the
28 preliminary activities carried out during the
29 application phase; and

30 WHEREAS, Max Chavez is functionally the proper person to
31 coordinate the activities and tasks required to
32 implement the objectives of the PONI program.


1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
2 Council that Max Chavez is hereby designated and
3 appointed as the official representative to coordinate
4 and direct all activities and events necessary to
5 implement the objectives and requirements of the PONI
6 project; and the Tohono O'odham Nation's officials in
7 cooperation and coordination with the Tohono O'odham
8 Judiciary are authorized to take whatever steps are
9 necessary to insure successful participation in the PONI
10 project.

11 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
12 on the 6th. day of December, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum
13 was present with a vote of 1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not
14 voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
15 Council by Section 1 (b)(c)(2)(6) & (f) of Article VI of the
16 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
17 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting
18 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March
19 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
20 Stat. 984).


