

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Payroll Advance for Max Jose)

RES. NO. 344-88

1 WHEREAS, Councilman Max Joe requested from the Legislative  
2 Council for a payroll advance to be issued on December  
3 9, 1988; and

4 WHEREAS, Policy No. 01-88, of the Budget and Finance Committee,  
5 "Payroll Advances and Early Check Releases" currently in  
6 effect is very specific on the issuance of a payroll  
7 advance; and

8 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council hereby waived the current policy  
9 to allow Councilman Max Jose to receive a payroll  
10 advance on December 9, 1988.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council  
12 hereby waives its current policy to allow Councilman Max  
13 Jose to receive a payroll advance on December 9, 1988.

14 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
15 on the 7th day of December, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum  
16 was present with a vote of 647.0 for; 595.5 against; 397.5 not  
17 voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
18 Council by Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of  
19 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation  
20 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
21 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,  
22 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.  
23 984).
