(Waiver of Policy for Nation's Employees)

RES. NO. 345-88

1 WHEREAS, the Christmas Holidays are upon us; and

2 WHEREAS, the current policies regarding check advances is
3 restricted to emergency type situations.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
5 Council that the policy of advance pay is hereby waived
6 in order for the Nation's Employees to make such request
7 if necessary.


8 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
9 on the 7th. day of December, 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum
10 was present with a vote of 1,587.5 for; 52.5 against; -0- not
11 voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
12 Council by Section 1 (p) of Article VI of the Constitution of
13 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
14 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
15 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
16 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
17 984).
