WHEREAS,	under	the 1	provisi	on	of	P.L	. 97-	293	í Sou	thern	Ar:	izona

- WHEREAS, under the provision of P.L. 97-293 (Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act of 1982) the Secretary of the Interior, acting through the Bureau of Reclamation, is mandated to improve and extend the existing irrigation system that is located on the allottees' lands utilized by the San Xavier Cooperative Association, Inc. for farming purposes; and
- WHEREAS, the San Xavier Cooperative Association, Inc. and the Secretary need to be assured of a sufficient CAP water supply prior to the actual rehabilitation of the allottees' lands utilized by the San Xavier Cooperative Association, Inc. for farming purposes; and
- whereas, under the provisions of article XVII, "Water Policies," of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, all waters which originate in or flow in or through the Tohono O'odham Nation, or which are stored in the Tohono O'odham Nation, whether found on the surface or underground, are a public resource of the Nation and the Tohono O'odham Council has the power to determine how these waters shall be used; and
- whereas, under the provisions of P.L. 97-293, the Nation will receive 50,000 acre feet of water to be delivered through the Central Arizona Project delivery system to the San Xavier Reservation as soon as possible but not later than October 12, 1992; and
- WHEREAS, the San Xavier Cooperative Association, Inc. has a present need for 4000 acre feet of CAP water and future

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need of up to 6,000 acre feet of CAP water to be delivered to the allottees' lands utilized by the Association for farming purposes; and

WHEREAS, under the provision of Article XVII, Section 2(c) the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has the power to regulate all water use within the Tohono O'odham Nation through a system of non-perpetual permits; and maintain a registry of such permits; and

whereas, at the present time, no permitting ordinance has been enacted by the Legislative Council, and therefore there is no mechanism in place for the issuance of a non-perpetual permit for CAP water use by the San Xavier Cooperative Association, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, it is essential for the continued development of the lands utilized by the San Xavier Cooperative Association, Inc., that this Council assure the Association that a non-perpetual permit will be issued to the Association for the use of 4000 acre feet of CAP water as soon as the water permitting ordinance is enacted by this Council and in the event permitting ordinance is not enacted prior to the need of this water by the Association the Association shall have the right to the use of 4000 acre feet of CAP water for farming purposes until this ordinance is enacted and the appropriate permit issued; and

WHEREAS, to continue a successful farming operation, it is the intention of the San Xavier Cooperative Association to acquire new leases from allottees in close proximity to its farming area for the expansion of its farming operation, and if successful, it will have a need for an additional 2000 acre feet of CAP water; and as these

2		assure the Association that a non-perpetual permit will

11	WHEREAS,	the San Xavier Cooperative Association, Inc., its

13		wish to waive any water rights or entitlement claims

15	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation, in a spirit of compromise,

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, in a spirit of compromise, believes it to be in the best interest of the Nation and the District to authorize the San Xavier Cooperative Association, Inc. to receive not less than 4,000 acre feet of CAP water nor more than 6,000 acre feet of CAP water annually for a period of twenty-five (25) years and for the period of any extension or renewal of the allottees' leases to the Association of their lands for farming purposes; and

WHEREAS, the San Xavier Cooperative Association, Inc., in a spirit of compromise, has agreed to accept the CAP water granted pursuant to a permit issued by the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

whereas, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes that the acceptance of the CAP water distributed to the San Xavier Cooperative Association, Inc., does not constitute a waiver of any water right or entitlement claims the San

Xavier Cooperative Association, Inc. and its members/allottees may have against the Nation and further recognizes that such acceptance does not in any way prejudice any water right entitlement claims the San Xavier Cooperative Association, Inc. and its members/allottees may have against the Nation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Council does hereby authorize the allocation of CAP water for farming purposes, of not less than 4000 acre feet nor more than 6000 acre feet of the 50,000 acre feet of water to be delivered to the San Xavier Reservation under the provisions of P.L. 97-293, to the San Xavier Cooperative Association, Inc. for a period of twenty-five (25) years and for the period of any extension or renewal of the allottees' leases to the Association of their lands for farming purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a water permit for the use and the term contained herein be issued to the Association for the 4000 acre feet of CAP water as soon as a water permitting ordinance is enacted by this Council and in the event a water permitting ordinance is not enacted prior to the need of this water by the Association, this Council does hereby authorize the use of this CAP water for farming purposes by the Association until a water permitting ordinance has been enacted by this Council and the appropriate permit issued.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the Association is successful in obtaining new leases from allottees in close proximity to it farming area for the expansion of its farming operation, additional water permit or permits shall be issued to the Association for an amount of water not to

exceed 2000 acre feet of the 50,000 acre feet of the water to be delivered to the San Xavier Reservation under the provisions of P.L. 97-293, to the Association for a period of time equal to the term of any new water acquired for farming expansion for the period of any extension or renewal thereof; and in the event a water permitting ordinance is not enacted prior to the need of this water by the Association, this Council does hereby authorize the use of this water for farming purposes by the Association until a water permitting ordinance has been enacted by this Council and the appropriate permit or permits are issued.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that nothing in this resolution is to be construed as a waiver of any water right or entitlement claims any party involved may have against each other, including the Tohono O'odham Nation, the San Xavier Cooperative Association and the Allottees.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 8th. day of December , 1988 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (i)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
