

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Override Veto of Resolution No. 345-88, "Waiving of Policy
for Nation's Employees)

RES. NO. 354-88

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council did by Resolution No. 345-88,
2 Waive the Budget Policy concerning payroll advances for
3 the Nation's Employees; and

4 WHEREAS, upon presentation of Resolution No. 345-88 to the
5 Chairman of the Tohono O'Odham Nation he did disapprove
6 thereof and returned it to the Council with his
7 objections in accordance with the provisions of Article
8 VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham
9 Nation; and

10 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has reviewed the Chairman's
11 objections and after consideration again voted to pass
12 Resolution No. 345-88.


13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legisla-
14 tive Council does hereby override the Chairman's veto of
15 Resolution No. 345-88, by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of
16 the votes cast 970.0.

17 The foregoing resolution was presented to the Tohono O'Odham
18 Legislative Council on the 16th day of December, 1988, at a
19 meeting at which a quorum was present and by a vote of 1,396.0
20 for; 58.0 against; 186.0 not voting; and 05 absent, was
passed by a majority of at least two-thirds (2/3) of the votes
cast and became law as provided in Section 5 of Article VII of
the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation.
