

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting the Draft National Indian Health Board Health Policy
Group Discussion Paper on Tribal Consultation with IHS)

RES. NO. 36-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes its right to
2 consult with the Indian Health Service on any and all
3 matters related to the delivery of health care services
4 to the O'odham; and

5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes that consultation
6 represents communication as a two-way process between
7 sovereigns; and

8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation believes that such a process
9 of communication can be enhanced and improved upon; and

10 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does recognize and appreciate
11 the efforts of the National Indian Health Board in
12 convening a group of tribal representatives to address
13 issues in consultation between the Tribes and Indian
14 Health Services; and

15 WHEREAS, this group did generate a set of recommendations to
16 improve Tribal/Indian Health Service consultation; and

17 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does wholly support these
18 recommendations; and

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legis-
20 lative Council seeks the support of the Arizona
21 Congressional Representatives in this matter.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
23 Council does request of the Indian Health Service the
24 immediate consideration of these recommendations.

25 AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
26 Council supports the development and publication of
27 implementation plans for incorporation of appropriate
28 recommendations into the operational policy of the
29 Indian Health Service.

30 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
31 on the 19th day of February, 1988, at a meeting at which a quorum
32 was present with a vote of 1,518.5 for; -0- against; 121.5 not
voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
Council by Section 1(c)(2) & (f) of Article IV of the Consti-
tution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting
