RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Funding for Tohono O'odham High School)

RES. NO. 39-88

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation continues to support full funding of the Tohono O'odham High School; and

WHEREAS, there exist needs to have additional funding to complete construction and start-up cost; and

WHEREAS, a feasibility study was conducted before the school was constructed showing a need to have cottages constructed for students who reside more than an hour bus ride from the school; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council respectfully request Congress to appropriate funding for the Tohono O'odham High School for student cottages, which was justified based on a feasibility study which indicated a need to have a residential program in place. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does consider the student cottages and start up cost as priorities and request continuous funding until they are completed.

The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 19th day of February, 1988, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(c)(2) & (f) of Article IV of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
