1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has annually
2 selected priorities to make funding requests from
3 Congress; and


4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is concerned
5 about the future funding of various programs and deems
6 it necessary to select at least four categories as
7 priorities.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham
9 Legislative Council does hereby select the following
10 areas as the Tohono O'odham Nation's priorities:


- 11 1. Roads
- 12 2. Housing
- 13 3. Education
- 14 4. Human Services

15 The foregoing resolution was defeated by the Tohono O'odham
16 Council on the 19th day of February, 1988, at a meeting at which
17 a quorum was present with a vote of 424.5 for; 856.5 against;
18 359.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested
19 in the Council by Section 1 (c)(2) of Article IV of the Consti-
20 tution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
21 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting
22 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March
23 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
24 Stat. 984).
