

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Priorities for Federal FY 89 Appropriations)

RES. NO. 43-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's appropriations Committee was appointed by  
2 Res. No. 24-88, composed of Harriet Toro, Chairperson; Rosita Ruiz,  
3 Vice Chairperson; Kenneth Chico, Sr.; Willard Juan, Sr.; and Virgil  
4 Lewis, and

5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has been advised that the  
6 sequestrations mandated by Gramm-Rudman (the Balanced Budget and  
7 Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985, P.L. 99-177) will have a very  
8 serious impact on future programs unless Congress substantially  
9 increases FY '89 funded Indian programs, and that they may have a  
10 devastating impact on future programs unless Congress substantially  
11 increases FY '89 funding level therefor; and

12 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham O'odham Legislative Council has appointed a special  
13 delegation of its members to travel to Washington, D.C. and testify  
14 before the Appropriate Committees of Congress concerning Federal FY  
15 '89 Appropriations for Indian programs; and

16 WHEREAS, in an attempt to inform Congress, the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
17 Council has attempted to prioritize and list those tribal programs  
18 which, if the funding levels therefore are reduced below present  
19 appropriations, would be most seriously affected and thus critically  
20 impact the education, health and welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation  
21 and its members.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that  
23 it respectfully urges Congress to assure that FY '89 appropriations  
24 to cover the following programs administered under the provisions of  
25 the Snyder Act, 25 U.S.C. 13, be set at such levels that they will  
26 not be affected either by sequestrations or executive rescissions,  
27 namely:

  - 30 2. Human Services
  - 31 3. Education
  - 32 4. Roads

1 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 19th  
2 day of February, 1988, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
3 of 823.0 for; 706.5 against; 110.5 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the  
4 powers vested in the Council by Section 1(c)(2) & (f) of Article IV of the  
5 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham  
6 Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
7 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section  
8 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
