

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(United Way Funding FY '89)

RES. NO. 50-88

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating
2 Juvenile Delinquency Prevention Services under an
3 agreement with United Way of Tucson; and

4 WHEREAS, such services for the youth have been successful and
5 beneficial; and

6 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does desire to enter into an
7 agreement for services during FY '89.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
9 Council that it does support and authorize the Tohono
10 O'Odham Nation to enter into an agreement with United
11 Way of Tucson for Juvenile Delinquency Prevention
12 Services.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
14 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate
15 the program in the interim while negotiations are still
16 being conducted and no executed agreement has been
17 awarded by the United Way of Tucson Agency.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
19 that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Treasurer of the
20 Tohono O'Odham Nation are hereby authorized to negotiate
21 and execute this agreement and any amendments thereto
22 for the duration of the contract, provided however, that
23 any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels
24 of this agreement shall be submitted for further prior
25 approval by this Council.

26 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
27 on the 7th. day of March, 1988, at a meeting at which a quorum
28 was present with a vote of 1,582.0 for; 58.0 against; -0- not
29 voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
30 Council by Section 1 (f) of Article IV of the Constitution of the
31 Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
32 January 18, 1936, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
984).
