2 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council enacted
3 Resolution No. 394-87 wherein it directed the Water
4 Resource Committee, San Xavier District Council and
5 their Consultants, Tribal Attorney and Tribal
6 Consultants to meet discuss and analyze Plan 6 and other
7 alternatives; and

8 WHEREAS, the Water Resources Committee informed the Council that
9 they have complied with the above mentioned resolution
10 by meeting, discussing and analyzing Plan 6 and other
11 alternatives; and

12 WHEREAS, the Water Resources Committee now recommends Alternative
13 9B which modifies the previous Development Plan 6; and

14 WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Chairman informed the Council
15 that the District does not support 9B Alternative and
16 were not involved in the drafting of the resolution,
17 therefore were not aware of the Committee's
18 recommendation to support 9B.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
20 Council that the Water Resources Committee
21 recommendation of Alternative 9B be referred back to the
22 San Xavier District for discussion between the District
23 Council and Consultants, Water Resources Committee and
24 the Tribal Attorney.


25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the issue be brought back to the
26 Legislative Council in May.

27 The foregoing Legislative Order was DEFEATED by the Tohono
28 O'odham Council on the 31st. day of March, 1988 at a meeting at
29 which a quorum was present with a vote of 428.0 for; 823.5
30 against; 388.5 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers
31 vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the
32 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting
Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March
6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
Stat. 934).


